Smartphone, Smart Watch And Earbuds Free Campus For Students Agreement

### In effect, August 1, 2024

### Spanish version

At Inter, our purpose is to teach with passion, while planning for the success of healthy, happy students. During the summer, I have had the opportunity to meet with fellow School Directors across the world, engage in book studies, and read the research on the impact of smartphones, smart watches and earbuds on our students. Based on the evidence and learning, collectively the Leadership Team has decided that Inter is committed to becoming a smartphone, smart watch and earbuds free campus for students.

The **WHY** behind our decisions is the care and concern we have for our students. With this change, we expect to see more community building, socialization and less issues with online bullying, stress, and invasion of privacy during school hours.

#### Research follows:

- → Heightened levels of teen depression and anxiety
- → <u>Dopamine production as real-world interactions</u>
- → Forever elsewhere
- → Belonging and learning
- → Feelings of alienation
- → Developing social skills, like conflict resolution
- → Kryptonite for attention
- → Addiction vs. satisfaction

Most schools say they ban phones, but that typically means only that students must not use their smartphone, smart watch and earbuds during class. This is an ineffective policy because it incentivizes students to hide their smartphone, smart watch and earbuds use during class and increase their smartphone, smart watch and earbuds use after class, which makes it harder for them to form friendships with the kids around them. \*This was the first and ineffective approach of Inter.

#### How:

- This year we will create a school where students are expected to leave *smartphones*, *smart watches and earbuds* at home.
- If necessary, they can have their *smartphone*, *smart watch and earbuds* in their backpacks, and all backpacks will remain in lockers. Keep in mind that the school will not be responsible for these items if lost or broken, as they should remain at home.
- Items must be turned off and cannot be visible (including in pockets) during the school day. Not during lunch, not in the hall, not anywhere until after the last bell rings. If there's an emergency and students need to contact parents, they may use their phone or the school phone ONLY in the Division Office. (*Lemov, D., 2022*)
- If a student's *smartphone*, *smart watch and/or earbuds* are seen, they will be taken to the office to be held for parent pick up.

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## What we need from parents:

- 1. Your on-going support, shared vision, and care and concern for the students.
- 2. Ask students to leave smartphones, smart watches and earbuds at home.
- 3. If you require the student to have a phone, remind them to leave it off when they arrive at school and can turn it on when the school day is over.
- 4. Remind your child to keep the *smartphone*, *smart watch and earbuds* concealed in their backpacks if they must bring them to school. They will not be able to keep them in their pockets.
- 5. Remind your child that if an adult sees a *smartphone, smart watch and earbuds*, even if it is not in use, we will confiscate it and wait for the parent to pick it up.

## **Expectations:**

This will not be easy. We expect push back and disappointment from students. Change is never easy, but we will remain steadfast for the mental health and benefit of our students.
